

# CHURCH SAFETY & SECURITY 101

Sample Policy & Procedure Plan

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This **Church Safety and Security 101 Sample Plan** is intended to provide an example of what might be contained in a plan for Faith based organizations. Depending on the organization's needs, additional policies and procedures would be included. For example, a procedure for monitoring groups that rent space in your building, or a policy addressing the safety needs of offering your facilities as an emergency shelter during an emergency or disaster, would require additional policy and procedures.

Policies and procedures work together, but they're separate concepts. Policies define your objectives. A policy might say: "We will provide a safe and healthy environment for the children in our nursery." Procedures describe how you'll accomplish the objective. Procedures are action steps and may say: "We carefully Screen and conduct Background Checks on all volunteers and staff members who work with or have contact with children;" or "Only the parent who drops off a child in the nursery may collect the child," and "All toys will be sanitized weekly."
